Verb To Be in the present simple + going to + main verb in the infinitive form without "to"

It's used to express a future intention, plans and things someone decided to do or not to do.

## Affirmative

I'm going to swim.  
He/ she / it is going to swim  
You / We / They are going to swim.

## Negative

I'm not going to swim.  
He/ she / it isn't going to swim  
We/ you / They aren't going to swim

## Interrogative

Am I going to swim?  
Are you/ we / they going to swim?  
Is she/ he / it going to swim?
