FORM

Will + infinitive (without to)



USE

- To predict the future (what you think will happen)
- To predict the future you usually use will with the following verbs and expressions: expect, believe, think, hope.
I believe I will get a good job.
- When you decide to do something spontaneously (decided at the moment of speaking).
I just decided. I will join the community service volunteer now.

FORM

Be+ going to + infinitive



USE

- To express an intention
Mark is going to London tomorrow.

FORM

Am / is / are + verb + ing



USE

- To talk about something that we have arranged or planned to do in the future.
What are you doing on Saturday Mark?
I'm raising money for a protest campaign.
